





- (ii.) The grantees shall pay the annual assessment of Rs. 60/- per year to the office of the Deputy Commissioner, Duggar or at before the month of June every year.

(iii.) The Grantees shall use the said land for the purpose of constructing and maintaining thereon a school building for Upper High School and for purposes ancillary thereto and shall not use it or the building constructed thereon or any part thereof or part of the same to be used for any other purpose whatever.

(iv.) The grantees shall not alien, sublet, or otherwise transfer the said land or any part thereof or any right whatsoever therein without the previous sanction in writing of the Governor.

(v.) The grantees shall abide by the rules and regulations of the State Government for the time being in force relating to the admission of students to the secondary stage and shall manage the institution and the land to the satisfaction of the Governor.

(vi.) The Grantees shall construct the school building in accordance with the plan previously approved by the Governor and shall not construct any other building thereon without the previous sanction in writing of the Governor, and also that the grantees shall the plans and design of the buildings to be constructed and works to be executed on the said land bearing distinctly upon them the name of the



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6. The Trustee would complete the construction of the building within three years of the delivery of the possession of the site back to the Trustee.

7. The trust fund would be liable to be reduced by the amount of the sum building differentiated thereby for any purpose other than that intended to construct (as) or where it is shown to be the cause of non-completion of any of the conditions hereinabove.

8. Should the said land be assessed at any time under clause 8(a) the Trustee shall have the option of—

- (a) retaining over the building constructed thereon no payment to the provider of their cost or present value whatever be the same, or
- (b) requiring the Trustee to remove such building and to restore the said land to the original condition within a reasonable time to be fixed by the Committee. Should the Trustee fail to comply with requirement within the period so fixed, the building would be sold immediately to the Committee.

9. (a) The Committee may at any time in this discretion require the said land otherwise than under clause 8,

(b) should the land be so retained under sub-clause (b) the compensation payable thereto shall not exceed the cost of the present value, whatever be less of any building constructed thereon.

10. Upon any day any question arises as to the "presently value" of any building constructed by the Trustee the opinion of the said Engineer, Building Surveyor, Surveyor State Surveyor shall be final and binding on the parties.

DEAR SIR/MS ... Esq. MURKIN,

This Deed is made this 11th day of December 1960 between
Mr. Dineshwar & P. Rangay Bhata (hereinafter called the Grantee)
which witnesses shall declare his successors in office of the
Society and the Central Province and Bihar Technical Classes in
Banaras Hindu, Banaras being a society registered under the
Society Registration Act, 1860 acting through the Secretary
hereinafter called the grantees which committee shall include
the committee amongst the other posts.

Whereas the grantees has requested the Committee
to the grantee a plot of land having area of 4000 sq.
ft or 9.20 acres situated at P. G. Colony No. 8/2/1 of area 111100.
Begun more particularly described in the schedule hereto
and the greater of areas situated on the said land known
and thereon enclosed plot will be referred to as the said land

and whereas the Committee having consented to the grantee
thereof, has awarded the grant of the said land to the grantees
grantee on the terms and conditions hereinafter mentioned:-

by these presents this date subjoined shall the Committee make
to the grantees a grant of the said land free of service but
subject to payment of annual rent amount of Rs. 30/- per
square yard eight per annum.

To hold the same for the purpose of constructing
and maintaining thereon a School Building subject to the
following conditions:-

- (i) The grantees shall pay the annual rent amount of Rs. 30/- per
sq.yd to the officer of the Society Committee, Banaras or
before the month of June every year.
- (ii) The Society shall use the said land for the purpose of
constructing and maintaining thereon a School Building the
Finger High School and for purposes auxiliary thereto and
shall not use it for the building constructed thereon for any
part thereof or permit the same to be used for any other
purposes whatever.



- (iii) The Governor shall not sell, mortgage, or otherwise transfer the said land or any part thereof or any right acquired under this grant without the written authority in writing of the Governor.
- (iv) The Governor shall abide by the rules and regulations of the State Government for the day being in force relating to the erection of buildings in the Territory which are not exempt by law from such regulation and the said Governor shall have the power to make such regulations as he may see fit for the better Government of the Province.
- (v) The Governor shall construct the said building in accordance with the plans previously approved by the Governor and shall not construct any other building thereon without the written authority in writing of the Governor, and also that the Governor shall get the plans and designs of the buildings to be constructed and made to be examined by the Surveyor General of Bengal and if approved by him the Governor shall have the same executed.
- (vi) The Governor shall consider the construction of the buildings within three years of the delivery of the possession of the said land to the Governor.
- (vii) The said land shall be liable to be removed by the Governor to the said building mentioned herein to do any work for any person other than specified in condition 111 of clause I or any person or persons in possession of any of the buildings herein specified.
- (viii) Should the said land be removed at any time after clause II the Governor shall have the option of
- (ix) Taking over any buildings constructed thereon payment to the Governor of their cost or present value whichever is less, and for requiring the Governor to remove and build them out to restore the said land to its original condition within a reasonable time to be fixed by the Governor. Should the Governor fail to comply with such regulation within the period so fixed, the building shall be sold immediately to the Governor.
- (x) As the Governor may at any time in the discretion granted the said land referred to in clause II,
- 111 Should the land be so valued under condition 111 the amount due against a transfer shall not exceed the sum of the amount due, whichever is less of any buildings constructed thereon

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


